BUFF – Big Ugly Fat Fellow

- Designed as a long-range, subsonic high altitude bomber – today's bomber:
 - Eight turbo-fan engines
 - 185 ft wide 159 ft long 40 ft tall (at the tail)
 - Crew of 5 (Pilots-2; Radar Nav, Nav, and EWO)
 - Range ~9,000 miles
 - Max Speed 650 mph
 - Max Ceiling 50,000 ft
 - Weapons A bunch




Wartime Experience



 Bomber (LRS-B)
 - Northrop Grumman
- Initial capability mid-2020s
- Costs of \$550M (FY2010\$)
- Number to procure is still pending but 100 is a starting point
